






New Pathway Structure ASA Curriculum Changes

Key Board Decisions

- New Exams Added
 - LTAM/STAM split to FAM + (ALTAM or ASTAM)
 - ATPA Advanced Topics in Predictive Analytics
- One Exam Removed: IFM will no longer be administered
- Three Micro-Credentials
- Travel time is not increased

Exams P and FM

- P Remove/Reduce select topics
 - Earlier accessibility
 - Limited changes still allow instant results
- FM Remove/Transfer select topics
 - Reduces redundancy in pathway
 - Eliminates outdated content
 - Limited changes still allow instant results



Exams FAM/ALTAM/ASTAM

- FAM
 - Basic topics from current LTAM and STAM
 - Even split between long-term and short-term
- ALTAM/ASTAM
 - Remaining advanced topics, plus new ones

Transition Rules – LTAM/STAM

Current Pathway Exams Passed ¹	Provides Credit for	New Pathway - Outstanding

LTAM only	ALTAM + FAM-L	FAM-S ²
STAM only	ASTAM + FAM-S	FAM-L ²
LTAM + STAM	FAM + ALTAM/ASTAM	None

- 1. Exams passed by spring 2022.
- 2. FAM-L and FAM-S are available only until June 2024.



Transition Rules — IFM/ATPA

Current Pathway Exams Passed	Provides Credit for	New Pathway – Outstanding ¹
No IFM	None	IFM ² OR ATPA ³
IFM	IFM ¹	None

- 1. New pathway requirements are met by having passed either IFM or ATPA.
- 2. IFM is available through November 2022.
- 3. ATPA will be open for registration January 1, 2022



E-Learning Modules Approach

- Contextualize technical material from prerequisite exams
- Raise earlier awareness of profession
- Develop level-appropriate EQ/AQ skills
- Format: e-Learning module and take-home assessment



Summary of Improvements

- Earlier accessibility
- Elimination of outdated content
- Elimination of redundancies
- Improved arrangement of topics
- Incorporates meaningful micro-credentials
- Expands education without lengthening pathway
 - Increase AQ/EQ skill-building
 - Increase analytics coverage

- Micro-credentials:
 - Recognize and demonstrate to employers their knowledge and skills gained along the pathway to ASA
 - Serve as "milestone markers" that remain with candidates
 - Elements of the micro-credentials count in full toward earning designations
 - Group together pathway components that represent distinct knowledge and skills



Micro-Credentials (continued)

- Micro-credentials:
 - Incorporate AQ/EQ and data science skills
 - Provide critical marks of candidates' progress through the system
 - Signal to employers the knowledge candidates have gained
 - Do not make candidates qualified or "signing" actuaries; reserved for designations




Affiliate Membership


